

Greenville Veterinary Clinic LLC – Boarding Information

Our boarding facility includes a dog room with eight inside runs and four spacious cages, and a cat room with four “kitty condos” as well as traditional cages. Both rooms are temperature controlled, with central heat and air conditioning.

All dogs are either leash walked or exercised in a spacious 30-foot enclosed runway several times daily. Unless directed otherwise, all dogs are fed twice daily. We feed either Science Diet or Iams, unless the pet’s own food is provided.

Cats are housed in spacious cages with raised, resting shelves for perching. “Kitty condos” also include a private litter box area, thereby removing the litter box from the resting and eating area. In cases where multiple cats are boarded from the same household, cats may be housed together in a kitty condo at the owner’s request. Cats are fed free choice dry Science Diet or Iams foods, and canned foods only as directed by owners. You are, of course, welcome to provide your own food if desired.

Arrival and Departure Times

Animals may arrive for boarding or be discharged during any normal office hours.

Normal office hours are as follows:

Mon., Wed., Fri., -- 8:00 am to 5:00 pm

Tues., and Thurs. -- 8:00 am to 7:00 pm

Saturday -- 8:00 to noon

In addition, pets may arrive or depart on

Saturday afternoon from 4:30 to 5:00 pm, and

on Sunday from 9:00 to 9:30 am and also from

4:30 to 5:00 pm.

Immunization Requirements

All pets presented for boarding must be current on the following immunizations:

- Dogs -- Distemper, Hepatitis, Leptospirosis, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus, Rabies, and Bordetella (Kennel Cough). Canine Influenza vaccination is also recommended.
- Cats -- Distemper (Panleukopenia), Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, Chlamydia, and Rabies. In addition, Feline Leukemia vaccination is highly recommended.

In an effort to protect all boarding animals, all pets will be inspected upon arrival for evidence of external parasites (fleas, lice, or ticks). If evidence of parasite infestation exists, animals will be treated at the owner’s expense.

All boarding animals must have proof of a negative internal parasite screen (fecal flotation) within the past 6 months. If this condition has not been met, a fecal flotation will be performed during boarding, and any needed deworming medication administered. This is done to protect all pets from possible parasite transmission.

Personal Belongings

You are welcome to bring personal belongings, such as toys, blankets, etc. However, please remember that when boarding, many animals may exhibit behavior quite different from home. They may soil their bedding or destroy chew toys simply due to the change in environment. If we notice this occurring, items will be removed from the cage or run. However, we cannot be held accountable for any damage done to personal belongings or injury incurred to pets from ingestion of such items. Please label all personal belongings.

Boarding Rates

A 20% discount will be offered off daily rates when 2 pets are boarded in the same cage or run.

Daily rates will be charged for day of admission, regardless of arrival time, and for day of departure, unless animal is discharged before 10:00 am.

Medication administration fee of \$1.00 to \$3.00 per day will be charged for administration of medication. Fee varies with frequency, amount, and type of medicine.

Since some animals will soil themselves during boarding, routine charges will apply for any necessary bathing.

Any animals requiring medical attention while boarding will receive the appropriate examination, diagnostic testing, and treatment by a staff veterinarian. You will be asked to specify upon admission if you request advance notice of any such procedures.

Please be prepared to leave a phone number where you or another authorized person can be reached in event of an emergency.
