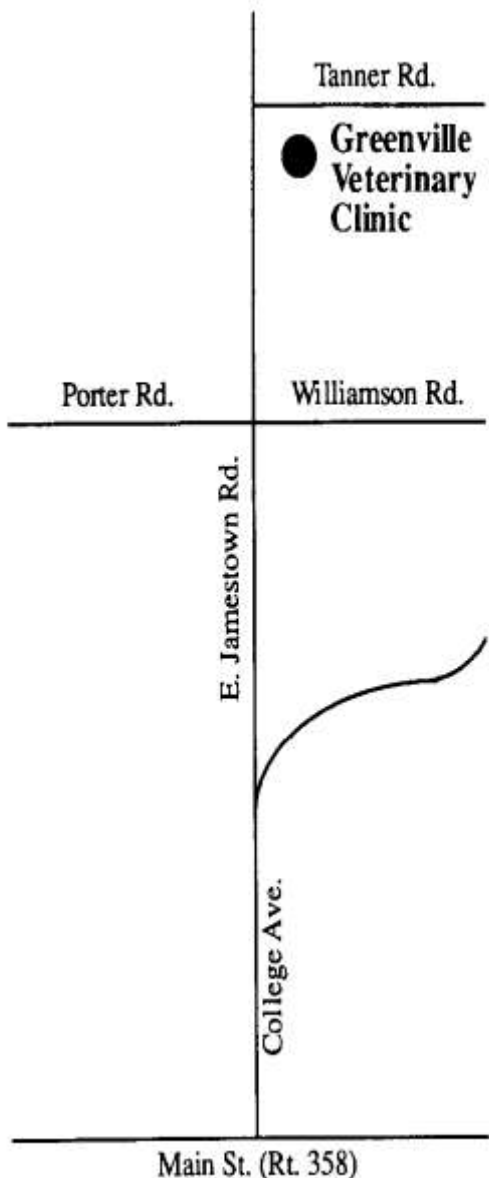

Most questions concerning vaccination schedules, nutrition, flea control and routine health care can be answered by a member of our technical team, thus allowing the doctors time necessary for their patients.

Hours/Appointments

Our normal business hours are:

Mon.-Wed.-Fri. 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Tues.-Thurs. 8:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

Saturday 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon

To allow ample time for all patients and scheduled surgical procedures, we see patients by appointment only. Like humans, pets do not synchronize their illnesses with our appointment book; and patient evaluations sometimes take longer than planned, so an occasional appointment delay is inevitable. Please realize that we make a sincere attempt to see each client on time; and a phone call is appreciated if an appointment needs to be rescheduled.

When you arrive for your appointment, please have your pet restrained, either on a leash or in a carrier. If you need to borrow a leash during your visit to our clinic, please ask a receptionist and she will provide you with one.

If you have an emergency requiring immediate attention after hours, please call our office number. You will be given directions on how to reach the doctor on call.

Farm Calls/Large Animal Service

Greenville Veterinary Clinic also offers a comprehensive farm call service for the surrounding area. Doctors are committed to providing preventative medicine as well as diagnosing and treating illnesses in all species of farm animals. We also have in-clinic facilities for hospitalization of animals requiring intensive care or surgical procedures.

Payment/Fees

Payment is expected in full at the time services are rendered, or upon discharge for hospitalized patients. We make every effort to maintain fair and reasonable fees consistent with the quality of service provided. An estimate of proposed fees will be provided upon request.

Hospitalization

For the safety of all hospitalized animals, we require that all vaccinations be up-to-date. Animals requiring treatment such as deworming, flea treatment, etc...will be treated at the owner's expense.
